Pratt explained the layout of the new COAs and will prepare sample sheets and an account list report to include the old account numbers (i.e. legacy numbers) as related to new account numbers. It was also agreed upon to combine the old T2A account and the T5 account within each district.

Hess commented signage will be placed near Latimer Road west of Hwy 132 for approximately 4 miles as road construction will begin soon. Hess is working on a possible survey of roadway of Clyde Road (3 miles stretch north of Hwy 11). District 1 will be working on the road west on Cherokee Street in Medford east of the baseball park. This project will include a new bridge and resurfacing the road. Hess will attend the State CED meeting in Oklahoma City on Wednesday.

Ronck reported District 3 has completed the hauling from Summers Blue Lake Quarry. The track-hoe and loader still need to be moved and must be moved by August 7, 2017.
