We need grass out front of the building and fence around the filter on West side.

1/2 pallet of tile needs to be moved into the building, along with 4 rolls of insulation.

Commissioners will do more checking on insurance.

Bryan Schultz called Rick Croft regarding event insurance for Alfalfa county. They have never had it. When dealing with horses, there is no liability.

The ADA is going to create a special contract for Prom & Farmers Grain.

Talked about heaters for the wet fire suppression system to keep it from freezing in the winter.
