**INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
FOR CIRCUIT ENGINEERING DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, The Interlocal Cooperative Act of Oklahoma Statutes 75§ 1001 et seq. enables county government to cooperate with each other to make the most efficient use of their powers and resources on a basis of mutual advantages; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Grant County authorizes the county to participate in a Circuit Engineering District with other counties who are within their Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma.
